

FILEstream Web Edition

FILEstream Web Edition is an optional add-on module for customers who need to provide their clients or staff with external access to their FILEstream data over the Internet or on an internal intranet.

FILEstream Web Edition gives you the ability to upload files directly into FILEstream and to search for files already within the system. This can be done from anywhere, over the Internet, and from any PC without the need to install FILEstream on that PC.

Files can be uploaded into FILEstream in three ways. You can send files directly into your own inbox, you can send files to another user so that they appear in their Inbox and finally, you can index files directly into a cabinet.

Files can be searched for in one or more cabinets by entering search criteria.

You can view a list of files in your Inbox or Search results. Files can then be downloaded and saved on the local PC for working with locally. Certain files which can be displayed by Internet Explorer can also be viewed directly by opening them in the browser. These include most image files, Word documents and PDF files if you have Acrobat Reader on the local PC.

Requirements

On the client PC, you need Microsoft Internet Explorer version 6.0 or later with Internet access in order to access your FILEstream database.

In your office, you need an internet facing web server with Microsoft IIS version 5.0 or later and the Microsoft .NET Framework version 1.1 or later. Additionally, you either need to have your FILEstream database (SQL Server) on the Web server machine or have the ability for the web server to see the SQL server if it is running on another machine. FILEstream Web Edition uses ASP.NET and runs under the special ASPNET account on the web server. FILEstream Web Edition cannot be purchased or installed on its own without first installing FILEstream on the web server.

Licensing

You need one additional workstation licence for the web server and a number of concurrent user licences for allowing access via the web.
